Due to the popularity of this workshop in June, we are scheduling another workshop in September. You can see a few Barn Quilts in the Town of Ontario and surrounding towns from the June workshop.

What is a Barn Quilt? It's a large square of plywood with a quilt block painted on it, then hung on a barn, shed, house, garage or just mounted on a post and displayed in your yard. Patterns for the blocks are copied from stitched bed quilts.

Join us for a morning or evening workshop and make your own Barn Quilt. The workshops will be held in the Barn at Heritage Square Museum, 7147 Ontario Center Rd., Ontario, NY.
