The film retrospective will begin on Thursday, March 5th at 7 pm and run every other Thursday night for the remainder of the year, including New Year's Eve!

With the generous cooperation of the Ohmann Theatre, we will present these films in the restored, comfortable theatre on one of the largest screens still in existence in the area. What a great way to introduce to neighboring community residents and visitors to our area, Lyons' historic downtown business district where they can enjoy a meal at one of our local restaurants before each showing and to walk the streets of our lovely village.

We are happy to announce that on Sunday, July 12th, there will be a special 70th anniversary screening of "Gone With The Wind" to be shown in its' entirety along with participation from some of the local Civil War organizations for demonstrations in period costumes. We feel this will be a great conclusion to Peppermint Days.

Of the 25 movies we will be presenting, some of them will have special dates to coincide with particular holidays and events. "The Wizard of Oz" will be our first in the series (March 5th) to coincide with Lyons Central School's musical production of "The Wizard of Oz". Some of the movies may also be shown in conjunction with particular high school literature classes.
